## Project Launch

Following the adoption of the new provincial Municipal Government Act in 2017, a working committee was established to study the possibility of forming a regional municipality for the Évangéline Region.

This newsletter is to inform you about the work accomplished to date and to keep you informed as the work continues.

Two public consultations were held last June and the following points emerged:

- More information will be needed to be better informed about a regional municipality.
- Consultants should be hired to conduct a study to provide more information in order to understand the potential issues.
- It will be important to keep the public informed of the process.

## The Work Ahead

The working committee includes representatives from the municipalities of Abram-Village and Wellington, the Conseil scolaire-communautaire Évangéline and members of the general public. The group hired a consulting firm, *Brighter Community Planning and Consulting*, to do a more in-depth study. The study will inform the public about the project's issues before proceeding to a regional municipality.

The public will be invited to participate in information and consultation sessions before decisions are made.
